

## **Workshop „Storytelling for Scientists“ (in English)**

### **Workshop description**

This workshop offers an insight into the basics of storytelling with the focus on designing a scientific talk in an interesting, compelling way. The participants learn how to create a red thread through their story in order to manage the audience's attention. Working with images and metaphors is key in this approach. In addition to the structural design, we will shed light on the delivery of a presentation in terms of body language and effective gesturing.

The trainer's artsbased approach invites the participants to broaden his/her range of action through hands-on practice and interaction. Based on art-making, role play and visualizations, the participants get a chance to test their strategies and to create new pathways to solution. Artsbased exercises generate learning through experience and through improvisation in order to overcome personal limitations and to expand one's play range.
